Safe storage and disposal of medications

Don't leave medication in places that are easily accessible to children or pets

Don't store medication in a bathroom/kitchen cabinet where humidity and temperature changes can cause damage.

Don't share prescription medication, they are prescribed for individuals based on medical histories and health factors, one medicine may work for one person but not another, and could cause serious harm/death.

DO lock medicine that is at risk for being abused in a cabinet, drawer, or medicine safe

DO keep medicine in a cool, dry place that is out of reach of children

DO store medicines in its original container – the label on the bottle will provide important information about the medicine.

DO speak to a receptionist if you are unsure on how to take, store or all other medication queries.

Do return all unused medication back to the chemist for safe disposal
